ADMISSION CRITERIA:

Admission criteria for degree students: All master's programmes require an undergraduate degree, usually in the same field of studies as the master's programme and which is the equivalent to a **Swedish B.A/BSc**.

English language proficiency demonstrated in one of the following ways: IELTS score (Academic) of 6.0 or more (with none of the sections scoring less than 5.0), TOEFL score of 550 or more (computer based test 213, internet based 79), Cambridge/Oxford - Advanced or Proficiency level, O level/GCSE, or having a Bachelor's Degree from a university where English is the ONLY language of instruction, according to the latest edition of International Handbook of Universities, or having received a passing grade in English course B (Swedish secondary school).
